The government is spending £10 million to test children in Reception classes. From this Autumn, many four and five-year-olds will sit tests in English and maths when they start school.

Heads, teachers, parents and education experts all agree: small children cannot be reliably tested and the results will provide no useful information about pupils or schools.

We can stop the roll-out of this pointless and damaging programme of standardised assessment.
