



WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT SATS

- SATs are imposed on schools by the government. 93% of headteachers and primary school leaders don't agree with this form of testing for primary school children.*
- SATs do not benefit your child, their school or their teachers in any way. They are used by the government to measure schools against each other.
- SATs lead to a stripped-down curriculum. Many year 6 pupils spend most of year 6 focusing on English and maths, just to sit narrow tests.
- SATs put unnecessary pressure on children and on teachers.
- More than one-third of children have not met the SATs standard over the last few years. Being told that you are "below the expected standard" is the wrong way to begin secondary school.
